

Victoria Quay

Victoria Quay is located to the north of Edinburgh City Centre. Pedestrian access is via Commercial Street, Ocean Drive and Dock Place. Vehicular access via Ocean Drive. There are facilities at Victoria Quay for **Video-conferencing** and **Tele-conferencing**.

Public Transport Provision

The nearest rail station to Victoria Quay is **Edinburgh Waverley**, which can be accessed by direct public bus services on Princess Street. There are several bus routes serving the immediate vicinity of Victoria Quay, with the 22 Lothian Bus the most direct service to Edinburgh City Centre which takes about 20 minutes. The majority of the buses are scheduled to arrive every 10-15min.

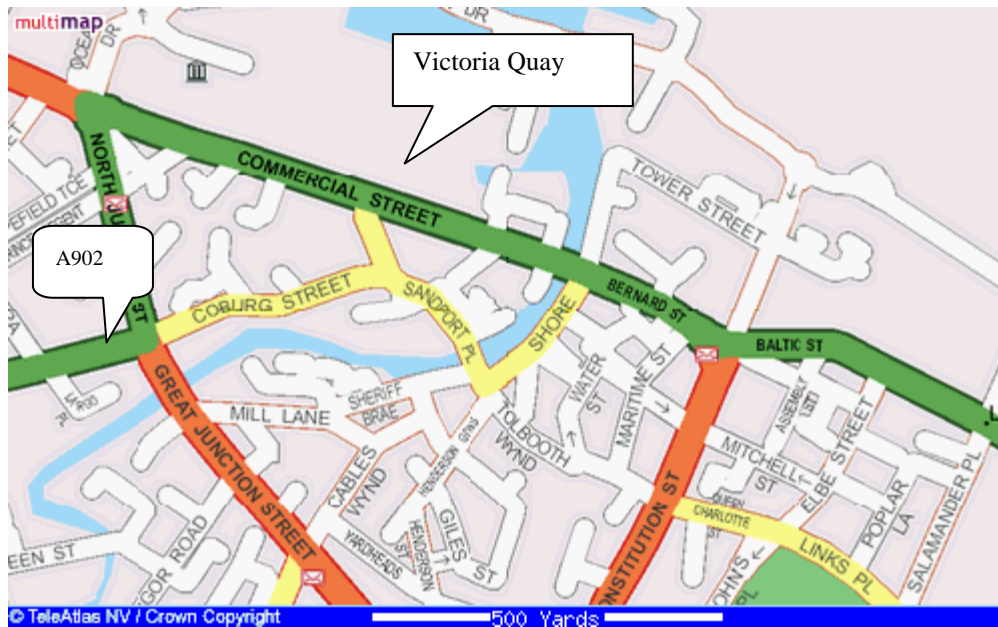
Car Parking

Air

Edinburgh airport is in easy access by bus via the city centre.

DIRECTIONS TO VICTORIA QUAY



Buses:

Services leave from stop outside St James' Centre at East End off Princes Street (exit station onto Princes Street, turn right and cross road). The journey costs £1.10, and takes approximately ten minutes. The 22 runs every four minutes, and stops on Commercial Street (A199 on map). The return bus stops outside Waverly.

Directions:

Forth Road Bridge/North:

Follow the main A90 into the city.
At Blackhall, take the A902 (left) towards Leith.
At the Crewe Toll roundabout, take the third exit (A902).
Continue on this road into Leith.
On reaching the crossroads with the A901 Great Junction Street, turn left.
At the traffic lights, cross into the Docks area onto Ocean Drive.
Victoria Quay is signposted from the next roundabout.

M8 / West:

Leave the motorway at Hermiston Gait (Junction 1)
Take the A720 City Bypass west towards South Gyle
At the roundabout, take the second exit (A8 City Centre)
At the next junction, turn left onto the A902
On reaching the Barnton Junction, turn right onto the A90
Follow directions as above

South / East:

From the A1 or the A720, take the A1 into the city at the Old Craighall Junction.
Follow this road into Leith, and turn right reaching the docks area. VQ is signposted from here.

Please note car park spaces can not be booked.
